## **MUSINGS & NOTES FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK**

Jesus often chastised or reprimanded the disciples for their lack of faith, because of their lack of understanding and belief in Him, their slowness to grasp what He was teaching them. So perhaps we should not be surprised at our hesitancy, our doubts and struggles to believe more deeply in Christ, to entrust ourselves fully to His will. We envy those who are able to have an almost blind faith in Christ, trusting with full confidence in Him, despite the great odds and adversities that seemingly stand in their way. We marvel at the example of the blind beggar, Bartimaeus, who cried out as Jesus was passing by: "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me!" Although he could not see Jesus physically at this point, he believed in Him and His power to heal him of his blindness. We should echo his prayer often in our daily lives, that Christ might heal us of our spiritual blindness, as it closely resembles the Jesus Prayer of the Eastern Churches: "Lord Jesus, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner." So often we are blinded by our preoccupation with this earthly life, those things we readily see and grasp with our hands and eyes, so that we fail that we are made for something more and greater than just this earthly life. We fail to listen to that inner voice of our conscience that we have made in the image and likeness of God our Creator, and that we have redeemed through the Paschal mystery of Christ's death and resurrection, adopted into His Sonship to become co-heirs in His glory to share fully in the life of heaven for all eternity. The letter to the Hebrews testifies to Abraham's faith as accounting righteous before God, as he journeyed towards the homeland God promised him. Might we use every occasion and opportunity to grow stronger in our trust and belief in Christ, who has gone before us to prepare a place for us so that we might be with Him and His heavenly Father in heaven forever. Let us strive to make all decisions about our way of life consistent with this heavenly goal and destination, in accordance with a greater conformity to Christ's teaching and example. Everything else is vanity and secondary to our primary destination. Lord Jesus, strengthen our faith!
