MUSINGS & NOTES FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR'S DESK

Today is only one week until the joyous celebration of the Nativity of the Lord!

In the first reading today, we hear the prophecy of Isaiah, "The virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall name him Emmanuel" (Isaiah 7:14). This is only one of the hundreds of prophecies that Jesus fulfilled in His lifetime.

Throughout the Old Testament, we see Jesus alluded to time and again. For centuries, the Israelites were waiting for the Messiah — waiting and hoping.

We can never allow the events recounted in Sacred Scripture to become commonplace and taken for granted. The Bible tells us that God became Man. The Lord of the universe came to earth for us, and He wants a relationship with each one of us.

He's not like a distant ruler living from afar. No, the Lord knows each one of us personally and calls us to be friends with Him in our daily lives. He loves us personally and teaches us personally.
