Reflections from the Administrator's Desk

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary occurs on Wednesday, December 8th, with three Masses to mark its importance to our Catholic life, as it is a Day of Obligation in the United States and many other countries, but not in Canada (we have only two days of Obligation: Christmas and the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on January 1st). Four days later, December 12th, we mark the feast of our Lady of Guadalupe (which this year falls on a Sunday which takes precedence over this Marian feast), and in between on Thursday, December 9th, we have the optional memorial for St. Juan Diego to whom Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared. For Mexicans and those of Hispanic background, this second feast rivals in popularity but liturgically the Immaculate Conception of Mary ranks in higher calibre.

The Immaculate Conception of Mary was the first stage or level God took in sending His beloved Son into our world through the mystery of the Incarnation. In anticipation of her special role in giving birth to the Son of God, God designed that Mary herself would be conceived without the stain of original sin and that she would be always full of divine grace, in that she was redeemed by Christ from the very moment of her conception so that preserved without sin she could give birth to Christ. The Church has had to contend with many heresies which have threatened the integrity of the Catholic faith, and one of the more virulent heresy was Arianism which denied the divinity of Jesus. As Anthony Esolen in the November issue of the *Magnificat* states: "There's all the difference in the world between believing that God sent a man named Jesus to speak in His name, and then "adopted" him as first of all creatures, and that God Himself became man to save man."
