Reflections for the Administrator's Desk

With the lifting of the provincial public health directives and subsequent protocols issued by the Archdiocese of Regina, as we summarized them in last Sunday's bulletin and how they will impact St. Mary's Parish, we pray and hope that many Catholics will return to the "in-person" celebrations of the Eucharist. This remains our prayerful intention for this month as we encourage many who have been remaining at home on Sundays to join us in the essential celebration of our Catholic faith both for our own good spiritually and for the vitality of our parish. You might encourage those who have not come back to Mass to do so, now that Holy Communion can now be ministered both on the tongue and in the hand. It would be a shame that, during this time of greater openness and near normal conditions, those who have been staying from attending Mass in our churches would not take this opportunity to receive both the Eucharist and Reconciliation during this window. Given what we have been living through over this past year and a half, and how often our hopes have been raised only to be dashed in the next announcement, it would be imprudent to simply assume that these conditions will continue on indefinitely and that further restrictions will not be introduced at some point over the next few months. Our Lord God desires that we take advantage of the graces available to us when we are able and not to be presumptuous about how long we shall live, so that we can postpone living into the mystery of these graces He so generously provides us. Just because Archbishop Don has extended the dispensation from Sunday Mass obligation until September 1st, if we are able to attend, should we not recognize God's call to return to the sacraments of the Church as frequently and often as we can. Nothing can take the place of the sacramental graces God pours out abundantly upon us. Let's not play cavalierly with the life-line God has thrown out in our direction. We are to hunger and thirst for the gift of Holy Communion more than for the earthly food we consume daily, because without It we cannot live.
