Reflections for the Administrator's Desk

For many years, this spot on the bulletin included the reprinting of the *Living With Christ* introduction to the Sunday Mass. However since reflection is readily available elsewhere, I will use it to share some spiritual “food for thought” beyond my homily. These reflections will address some more practical instructions on the Archdiocesan protocols that are being proposed in light of the lifting of all public health restrictions as of **Sunday, July 11th**, as summarized for our particular parish situation. **Masking** is left to the discretion of the individual and their comfort level. **Physical distancing** is no longer required, but some might prefer some space. Contact tracing, record keeping and phoning ahead are not required. All washroom and commonly touched surfaces will receive enhanced cleaning and disinfecting, as will hand hygiene with sanitizers. **Holy Water fonts** are restored with replenishing of Holy Water regularly. Singing by choir and congregation may resume. For now, collection baskets will be left at the front and those at the back might bring their offerings at Communion time. Since there is some reluctance to shaking hands, the **Sign of Peace** will not resume, as it became a distraction to many and had lost any spiritual connection to being reconciled with others while bringing your gifts to the altar. Quietly pray for peace. **Holy Communion** can be received on the tongue or in the hands. Communicants may resume the usual practice of coming up to the front to receive Holy Communion standing. Those communicants who wish to receive Holy Communion while kneeling may kneel in the designated first pews on either side. Those with mobility issues may raise their hands or otherwise identify themselves and seating themselves near the centre aisle or side aisle, I will minister Holy Communion directly to them where they are seated. Since these measures are “new”, please be patient, offer constructive suggestions as you recognize possible improvements, as we fine tune these measures for the good of all parishioners. Thank you for your attendance, support and cooperation in the past 1 ½ years.
