## Reflections from the Administrator's Desk

### THE SEVEN GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

The gift of **Fear** fills us with a sovereign respect for God, making us dread nothing as to offend Him by sin. Arising not from the thought of hell, but from sentiments of reverence and filial submission to our heavenly Father, this fear is the beginning of wisdom, detaching us from worldly pleasures that could separate us from God. Begetting in our hearts a filial affection for God as our most loving Father, the gift of **Piety** inspires us to love and respect for His sake persons and things consecrated to Him, those who are vested with His authority, His Blessed Mother and the Saints, the Church and its visible Head, our parents and superiors, our country and its rulers. Here the practice of religion is not a burdensome duty, but a delightful service. By the gift of **Fortitude** the soul is strengthened against natural fear, and supported to the end in the performance of duty. It imparts to the will an impulse and energy moving it to undertake without hesitancy the most arduous tasks, to face dangers, to trample under foot human respect, and to endure even lifelong tribulation. The gift of **Knowledge** enables the soul to evaluate created things at their true worth--in their relation to God. Knowledge unmasks the pretense of creatures, reveals their emptiness, and points out their only true purpose as instruments in the service of God. It shows us the loving care of God even in adversity, and directs us to glorify Him in every circumstance of life. Putting first things first, one prizes the friendship of God beyond all else. **Understanding**, as a gift of the Holy Spirit, helps us to grasp the meaning of the truths of our holy religion by faith we know them, but by Understanding we learn to appreciate and relish them. It enables us to penetrate the inner meaning of revealed truths and through them to be quickened to newness of life. The gift of **Counsel** endows the soul with super-natural prudence, enabling it to judge promptly and rightly what must be done, especially in difficult circumstances. Counsel is supernatural common sense, a priceless treasure in the quest of salvation. Embodying all the other gifts, as charity embraces all the other virtues, **Wisdom** is the most perfect of the gifts. It is the gift of Wisdom that strengthens our faith, fortifies hope, perfects charity, and promotes the practice of virtue in the highest degree. Wisdom enlightens the mind to discern and relish things divine, in the appreciation of which earthly joys lose their savor, whilst the Cross of Christ yields a divine sweetness according to the Saviour's words.
