Day 5: Strength: Breaking bread for the journey. Acts 27:33-36; Psalm 77; Mark 6:30-44

Day 6: Hospitality: Show unusual kindness. Acts 28:1-2, 7; Psalm 46; Luke 14:12-24

Day 7: Conversion: Changing our hearts and minds. Acts 28:3-6; Psalm 119:137-144; Matthew 18:1-6

Day 8: Generosity: Receiving and giving. Acts 28:8-10; Psalm 103:1-5; Matthew 10:7-8
