TODAY'S GOSPEL IS one of great mystery: the Transfiguration. Moses and Elijah appear next to Jesus, who himself is completely transfigured, radiating pure light. Imagine yourself there...the sight must have been out of this world! In the face of all this glory, Peter's first reaction is to set up three dwellings, offering them worldly comfort.

How often is God right in front of us, showing us his divinity and his plan for our life, and we focus on logistics and worldly preoccupations?

As a matter of fact, today during Mass, we will witness one of the greatest miracles of all time: bread and wine becoming Jesus' body and blood. The Eucharist is the sacrament where we get a glimpse of God's glory and power. For a moment, heaven and earth meet. As we witness this miracle today, where will our heart and mind be? Will we be checking the time, or revelling in God's glory? Will we be thinking about the things we need to do this week, or listening to God speak our heart?

God's words to the disciples are a wake-up call: "Get up and do not be afraid." They prompt us to refocus on what's important: not worldly consideration, but an attentive ear and an open heart his ever-living word, calling us to be examples of heaven here on earth.
